UNF's Florida Postsecondary Comprehensive Transition Program (FPCTP)

To empower students with intellectual disabilities, fostering their academic, social and professional growth in an inclusive and supportive environment.



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USoar students will:

- Audit courses across fall and spring, with optional summer terms for 3 years
- Participate in internships or work-based learning (5-20 hours per week)
- Attend content-specific seminars
- Take part in collaborative opportunities to develop skills and knowledge directly linked to obtaining employment
- Develop a clear understanding of employment goals and how to accomplish them
- Participate in campus life and studentoriented events
- Earn individual micro-credentials aligned with the NACE's Career Readiness Competencies
- Complete a NACE Career Readiness Certificate
- Earn a Certificate of Career Development (COCD)

Program Benefits:

- Accepted students who remain in good standing are eligible to receive up to a \$15,000 scholarship to support course completion and offset related expenses (tuition, housing, meals and materials)
- Cohort model with Fall admittance only
